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Executive Summary

The development of the Rural Area Plan for Patharghata Upazila has been influenced by the policies, strategies, and planning standards outlined in the Structure Plan. Six unions of the Patharghata Upazila were taken into account when creating the rural area plan. The local government at the Upazila level has no prior experience putting such plans that integrate rural areas into action. There is no comparable expertise with carrying out physical designs at the rural level. This project's plan preparation will be their first opportunity to put physical plans into action at the Patharghata Upazila union level.

Rural Area Plan aims to guide the physical development of Patharghata Upazila including all the economic and social activities. Considering the local people demand from the PRA and based on the planning standards, about 91.74 acres of land has been proposed for educational facilities purpose, about 46.43 acres of land has been proposed for commercial activities purpose, about 3.01 acres of land has been proposed for health facilities purpose, about 16.22 acres of land has been proposed for open space and recreational facilities purpose, about 54.97 acres of land has been proposed for community facilities purpose, about 2763.96 acres of land has been proposed for Transportation and Communication purpose, about 17360.44 acres of land has been proposed for Rural Settlement purpose.

It should be remembered that this development plan serves as a methodical blueprint for growth development and management. Authorities, responsibilities, and the extent of planned development in each Upazila Parishad and Union Parishad region are specified by the current Local Government Acts. Legal obligations and opportunities for coordinating development within the Upazila exist for the Upazila Parishad.

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CHAPTER- 1: INTRODUCTION

1.1 Introduction

Rural Area Plan is prepared as per the Terms of Reference (TOR) of the project. The policies, strategies, and planning standards adopted in the Structure Plan have guided the process of preparing the Rural Area Plan for Patharghata Upazila.

1.2 Background of Rural Area Plan

The process of raising the standard of living and economic security of rural residents is known as rural development. Rural Area Plan, which addresses the development of rural areas within the project area, offers a long-term strategy for 10 years. The People's Republic of Bangladesh's Prime Minister emphasizes the importance of providing all metropolitan amenities for rural residents in order to improve their quality of life. In order to realize the "Amar Gram-Amar Shohar" vision, the government must provide rural residents with access to urban amenities such as electricity, increased trade and business, development of all forms of communication, planned housing and sewage systems, clean drinking water, healthcare facilities, and internet and technology-based communication. This chapter discusses the most pressing issues discovered during the rural sector PRA, and suggested facilities for the rural area.

1.3 Objectives of Rural Area Plan

Rural Area Plan will be a statutory guide and control for development of the six unions of Patharghata Upazila. This plan is prepared on mauza map with sectoral development proposals. The Rural Area Plan is aimed to determine the present and future functional structure of the rural area, including land use and provide infrastructure proposals for improving and guiding development of rural area of Patharghata Upazila. The objectives of the plan will be attained through orderly location of rural land uses and location of different services and facilities.

1.4 Area Coverage under Rural Area Plan

Patharghata Upazila is located at Barguna District in the southern part of the country. Patharghata became police station in 1925. It was upgraded to an upazila on the November, 1983. Nothing is definitely known about the origin of the name of this upazila. But there is a popular hearsay that the famous saint Khawaja Khan Jahan Ali took rest at the river station (ghat) situated at the meeting place of the rivers. The upazila might have derived its name from the very words Pathar and Ghat. Baleshwar and Bishkhali while carrying stones (Pathar) from Chittagong to Bagerhat for constructing the Sat Gombuj Mosque.

The Patharghata Upazila consists of 7 Unions and one Pourashava with an area 318.38 sq.km (1804.34 acres).




Figure 1: Administrative of Patharghata Upazila

CHAPTER- 2: EXISTING LANDUSE SCENERIO

2.1 Introduction

The current chapter of the report is about Rural Area Plan covering its development plan proposals. This chapter also describes the existing land use scenario; list of major problems compiled from rural PRA, functional hierarchy of different unions of rural area, future land requirement for different facilities, and proposed facilities for rural area of Patharghata Upazila.

2.2 Existing Land Use Pattern

Except for the core area of Pourashava, topographically, Patharghata Upazila is mainly rural in nature. Some Unions are mainly containing urban characteristics. But in recent years, communication development has already impacted the growth and expansion of activities within the paurashava. The existing land use of the Upazila shows that 56.55 percent of the land is used for agricultural activity, and other mentionable land-use area are: 17.51 percent rural settlement, 7.62 percent vacant land and 6.99 percent forest area. Table 18 illustrates existing landuse statistics in detail.




Figure 2: Existing land use *Source: PKCP project, UDD, 2018*

CHAPTER- 3: TRANSPORTATION AND TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT GUIDELINES

3.1 Introduction

This section of the Rural Area Plan (RAP) intends to set out some guidelines for the transport sector development and its relevant institutional setup. The major areas of concern are network and infrastructure, traffic regulations, services, and institutional aspect. Also, different instructions are grouped under individual guidance notes on different topics.

The critical question here is how far the scenario of the future can be predicted with some level of accuracy. Specially, in a sector like transport that is heavily dependent upon technology, the underlying assumptions can shift quickly that can turn much of the decisions invalid.

3.2 Existing Conditions of Transportation Facilities

A comprehensive transportation study is undertaken to investigate the existing transportation infrastructure, transportation modes and modal share scenario of Patharghata Upazila and to estimate the anticipated transportation needs of the town up to the year 2031. Accordingly, the transportation study is conducted to determine the present travel patterns and the characteristics of existing transportation facilities to forecast the future travel demand and develop a transportation guidelines. Traffic volume survey has been conducted to find out the scenario of average daily traffic, peak hour traffic and off-peak hour traffic. Origin-Destination survey has been carried out to know the pattern of traffic generation, traffic distribution, traffic modes and traffic costing, travel behavior etc. Growth center survey has been conducted at 19 points on Upazila to determine the traffic congestion factors and conditions. Stakeholder interview has been accomplished to understand the traffic conditions in this area and find out the potential decisions to solve traffic problems.

3.3 Existing Road Network

From the transportation survey and public consultation in the PRA session, it is unveiled that congestion is caused by on-street parking, a narrow road network, and a lack of parking. Local people also emphasized how ferry crossings add a significant amount of time to travel. Land use, environmental quality, economic growth and viability and achieving lifestyle

objectives are obvious factors that must be considered in evolving a comprehensive plan. However, there are subtler factors that will have a bearing on the outcome of these comprehensive transportation studies. The condition of existing internal connecting roads is very bad. Traffic congestion occurs during the rainy season and flooding as roads go underwater and become muddy. None availability of parking facilities for vehicles, lack of public transport facilities, unplanned ghat and terminal design, insufficient numbers of ghats and terminals, lack of access to Rivers and Canals that are not properly dredged and narrow roads are major critical issues in the transport sector.

In Patharghata Upazila, considering road length, it is found that the majority of the roads are tertiary category (Table 4) which area mainly Katcha road with narrow road width and bumpy surface. Primary roads directly connect this Upazila with Mathbariya, Bamna and Barguna Sadar Upazila.

From Physical feature survey, it is found that around 53.4% of Roads are katcha in Patharghata upazila and also the total length of katcha roads are longer than others. In patharghata Upazila, only 28.39% of roads are pucca.




Figure 3: Transportation and communication network of Patharghata Upazila *Source: PKCP project, UDD, 2018*

3.4 Existing Waterways

Water transport network of Patharghata Upazila has significant importance in carrying both people and goods. Boat, trawler and launch are used for carrying both passenger and commodity frequently.

3.5 Others Transportation System

At this stage there is no need to propose car way, rail way in this Pourashava.

3.6 Transportation Development Plan 3.6.1 Future Projections and Travel Demand Forecasting

With the increase of population, demand on travel will be increase with the time. Estimating the demand for transportation facilities and services is one of the most important analysis tasks in transportation planning. The demand includes not only passenger travel but also the movement of goods. Whether conducting a regional transportation planning study or examining the impacts of transportation of a new development site, estimating expected travel demand at some future date is critical point of departure for transportation planning.

According to Transportation survey, The project area is enriched with the water network and people feel comfortable and reliable in water transport so people use water transport for travel even in long distance directly. Patharghata is fully segregated by water route from other upazila say Barguna Sadar or Galachipa so people mainly use water route to travel from these upazilas. From The survey, it is seen that most of the waterways trips around 39% are generated from Patharghata Pourashava to Barguna Upazila and 57% trips are generated from Kakchira Ghata to Barguna.

Vehicular trips are distributed within the upazila mainly in Patharghata and Kakchira which are two well established unions in this upazila. As this upazila is connected with other upazila by zila road and regional highway so trips are distributed to other upazilas and other external area; Barisal, Bhola, Patuakhali etc. From The survey, about 50% motorized trips are generated from Patharghata Bazar to Kakchira Union and 30 trips are generate from Patharghata Bazar to Char-Duani Union. So, it is necessary to improve this roads as planning decision.

3.6.2 Road Network Plan


Patharghata is a small town with a very low volume of internal and external traffic movement. Considering traffic volume and discussion with Paurashava authority and PRA, consultants have established a road hierarchy based on the functional area within the Paurashava as well as the internal and external linkage. Existing Access roads will be connected with Tertiary and Secondary roads for better mobility. Following table shows the standard of future development of road network.



CHAPTER- 4: DRAINAGE AND ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT GUIDELINES

This chapter states about existing conditions, Sub-basin catchment area analysis and methodology of Drainage Development Plan. A brief inventory of the existing drainage system of Patharghata has been made. While assessing the drainage conditions, the serviceability, structural conditions, obstruction, siltation, blockages are taken into consideration. And finally describe the drainage and environmental management plan, and its implementation strategies.

4.1 Existing Drainage Network 4.1.1 Man-Made Drainage Network

There has only 5.86 km of drainage network at Patharghata Paurashava area. There is no formal drainage network in rural area of this upazila.

4.1.2 Natural Canal & River

Table 7 represents the present scenario of existing waterbody of patharghata Upazila. There is existence of canals, ditches, ponds, fish ponds, and river. Majority of water bodies of this upazila are canals which is 46.66% and Bishkhali is the major river flowing through this Upazila.

There are linkages between natural and man-made drains. But how much effective and active the linkage is with the poorly maintained man-made drains is a question. Almost half of the depth of the man-made drain is filled with solid waste; as a result, the channel is not functioning properly.




Figure 5: Existing Waterbody Type in the Upazila

CHAPTER- 5: RURAL AREA PLAN

5.1 Introduction

This chapter contains Rural Area Plan of each individual Union. First, the issues prevailing in different Unions have been briefly described followed by description of Development Proposals in Rural Area Plan for each Union.

5.2 Background

The Rural Area Plans are prepared under the framework of Structure Plan and Regional Plan. The Rural Area Plans contain details of development proposals at Union level including the problems and opportunities existing therein and also include the proposals made in the upper level plan that is in the Rural Area Plan. The Rural Area Plans have been formulated for execution within a period of 10 years.

Rural Area Plan is a vital part of the current plan package as far as Strategic development and development control is concerned. Absence of Rural Area Plan not only hampers undertaking of development projects by planning authority, but also leads to uncontrolled and unwanted Strategic development in the private sector. Land use zoning is also provided in the Rural Area Plan to enable detailed view of proposed land use and development.

5.3 Land Use Categories in the Rural Area Plan

The Rural Area Plan (RAP) is prepared with a number of detailed land use categories to guide the implementation of the Rural Area Plan in a planned manner. Separate land use categories are considered for the rural area of Patharghata Upazila. The land use categories considered for the Rural Area Plan of Patharghata Upazila are provided in Table 8.

5.4 Rural Area Plan for Char Duani Union 5.4.1 Demography

Char Duani Union is situated on the western part of the Upazila and Kathaltali union is on the north, Patharghata on the south, Kalmegha union on the east and Baleshwar River on the west.

Present population of the union is 26,438 (2022) and it will 30,778 in the year 2031 and 32,712 in 2041. Density of population is 707 persons per acre and it will be 591 in the year 2031.

5.4.2 Review of Existing Land Use

Out of total 12874.94 acres of land of this union, more than 1558.96 acres of land i.e. 12.1% is used in residential. The agricultural use with 4789.83 acres, occupies 37.2% of total land, water bodies 41.57%, commercial use 0.54%, Forest 0.08% and Transportation and Communication 0.26%. Only 0.14% of land is used as education facilities.




Figure 6: Rural Area Plan for Char Duani Union

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


Figure 7: Rural Area Plan for Kakchira Union




Figure 8: Rural Area Plan for Kalmegha Union




Figure 9: Rural Area Plan for Kathaltali Union




Figure 10: Rural Area Plan for Nachna Para Union




Figure 11: Rural Area Plan for Patharghata Union




Figure 12: Rural Area Plan for Raihanpur Union

CHAPTER- 6: CONCLUSION
